5. Payments made for sewer, land divisions, zoning permits, etc. may be left in our drop box located just right of the double doors, if you want a receipt, just leave a note with your fees telling us where to send them.

7. If you have an urgent Cemetery need for lot purchases or burials, please call 989-236-7728, and we will assist you as soon as possible.
