

Trash Items that can be accepted include:

- <u>BUILDING MATERIALS COLLECTION</u> PRE-APPROVE BEFORE MAY 21st, by calling the Township office.
- <u>Electronics</u> Collecting all types of electronics— computers, TV's, cell phones, printers, etc. Disposal charges are reduced this year and only needed for old tube TV's and large flat screens. Please contact the office for more information. Computer hard drives are safely destroyed so no personal information is compromised.
- <u>Passenger Tires</u>; <u>First 6 small tires will be accepted at no cost to township residents</u>,
 anything over 6 tires will incur a \$2 fee per tire, larger tires will be charged the specified
 disposal fee/tire. Contact office for details.*
- Non-working Appliances have to be without Freon, Refrigerators and Freezers must be tagged. Scrap Metal and Old car/truck batteries will be collected to defray costs of the Clean-up Day Event.
